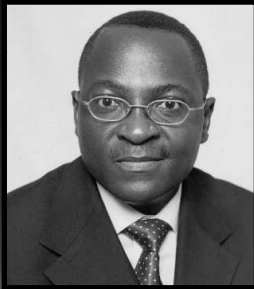

THE TESTIMONY OF TIMOTHY WAIVE

*"The Spirit bade me go, nothing doubting" Acts 11:12
"Whereupon I was not disobedient to the heavenly vision" Acts 26:19*

I usually shy from using ministry platform in discussing my family. Moreover my culture is to be discreet when discussing my children with others. But I can't run away from sharing this testimony. My wife and I just returned from a ministry trip to the United Kingdom. That is no news as ministry trips around the nation and the world has become a regular feature of our lives. What is news here is our visit to our son Timothy at his University in the UK Midlands. I was so overwhelmed by the reality of God's power and love at work in the lives of his children. Truly God is faithful. I knew I had to share this testimony as a way of showing my gratitude to God and encouraging others. There are several dimensions to this incredible story of God's reliability. Indeed I am at a loss as to where and how to begin. God's name be praised in all.

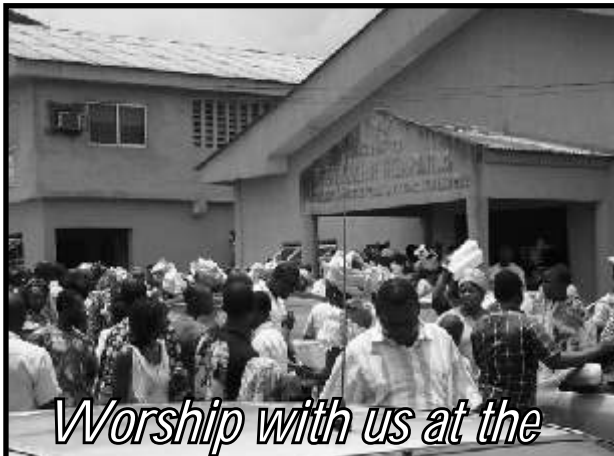
If someone had told me a couple years ago that my child will study overseas, I would never have believed it. Like we say in Warri, "who give fowl teeth?" but here we are standing amazed at God's work. Our first two sons have graduated from Nigerian Universities studying law. The first from a State Government owned University and the

second from a Private University. To my wife and I, this is miracle enough. The story of how God provided until their graduation is left for another day. Perhaps we will be able to tell a bit of it at the thanksgiving service billed for the Sunday after their 'call to bar'. God has highly favored us. The encouragement is that if he did it for us, he can do it for you also.

When the private university where Timothy was studying medicine in Nigeria began to have problems with the "Medical and Dental Council of Nigeria" as well as the Nigerian Universities Commission, we were worried like other parents. We prayed and urged Timothy to study something else. Since he was a Science student, Engineering was my suggestion. But Tim will have none of that. He stayed home for over a year. When he got the admission to the UK University, paying the fees and obtaining the visas was the first sign of God's involvement. We stood awed as God did his work. Let me use this media to appreciate all those that God used locally and overseas.

The crucial aspect of the testimony really is the health challenge Timothy went through when he was barely eight years old. I have never seen anything like that in all my life and have asked God not to let anyone see a thing like that in their lives. For nearly one year we battled for Timothy's life and then health. It is amazing that today he is training to become a doctor. Anyway, that is what he always desired from childhood. To become a doctor who has power to make sick people well again!

I remember vividly how it all started. I had just

returned from preaching in a village church that night but first drove to the church. At the door I heard the telephone ringing. It was before the era of the cell phone in Nigeria. How timely I thought as I rushed to answer the call. It was my wife at the other end, saying I should rush home as all was not well with Tim. When I arrived a Nurse who lived nearby had administered malaria treatment and we all prayed but the restlessness of the boy made us rush him to a private clinic near our residence. Government hospitals were on strike. Next day, we were asked to take him to a Children Specialist as the restlessness was increasing and very usual to the doctor. The pediatrician we took him to was also at a loss after a week of treatment without improvement. We had to take him elsewhere. That was how we moved from one hospital to the other.

After over two months and the situation had not improved, Rev Onofurho gave us a note to Dr Ofovwe Consultant Pediatrician at the University of Benin Teaching Hospital. We ended up staying at UBTH for over four months. Every kind of test known to medical science was done. We were spending money in the thousands daily. Yet Tim was not getting better. The experts concluded it was encephalitis. We were told that the chances of his survival were very slim and if he made it at all, he will end up as a vegetable and never be normal all through life. The Children Ward at the hospital at that time was filled with children with similar cases. Many died before our eyes. Parents took several others home to die rather than watch them become vegetables. Others could not afford the heavy antibiotics needed daily and the several scans, x-rays and tests required regularly.

Today as I look back at the whole event, I want to thank all members of our church, friends and relatives who stood solidly with us in prayers and financial support. I also recognize the strength of my wife who never shock all the time and charged me to be strong whenever I cried. My late mother was there for us too. We also got cruel mocking from some people who questioned our relationship with God and concluded we must be sinners or not called by God. There were also those in our families who thought the traditional fetish way was the solution and we were ostracized for standing on what we believe.

After many months the doctors advised that we take Timothy home and continue a regime of antibiotics and physiotherapy. They first asked us to come weekly for checkups and this was later reduced to fortnightly and then monthly. About seven weeks after, Tim started communicating well again and gradually calmed down. On our next appointment, the doctors could not believe their eyes. They had to run all the tests again and subject the mother and I to several interviews. What did we do to Tim? They couldn't find any trace of the illness! They took photographs and talked about reporting his story in their journal. They eventually stopped us from coming monthly. God has perfected his work! His name be praised. Another aspect is that we came out of this experience debt-free!

This is well over ten years now. Timothy has been healthy and very bright academically. In character, he is a pride to us. He has grown to become a strong handsome young man. And look at how God is giving him the best education that is available on planet earth. The devil certainly is the loser. I know that God still has more for Tim that will shame the enemy. I pray that this testimony be a blessing to you. I pray that you will be encouraged in the matter of your children and other areas of life where you might be facing challenges. God will give you the victory. 'For whatsoever is born of God overcomes the world; and this is the victory that overcomes the world; even our faith!' (1 John 5;4)
