CHRISTIANITY NO BE JUJU

*"The Spirit bade me go, nothing doubting" Acts 11:12
"Whereupon I was not disobedient to the heavenly vision" Acts 26:19*

The subject of this article was first used in a radio message earlier in the year and the response was amazing. We had to repeat the broadcast so many times. Since we began our Radio ministry in February 1999, as far as this message is concerned the demand for tapes and re-broadcast as well as follow-up phone calls far exceed others in the recent past. Other popular radio topics had been ; Vanity of vanities, why I persuade men, the place called hell, total experience, the joy of salvation, the cup that Jesus drank etc Our recent use of the local Pigin English in preaching the gospel on radio has also been well received. Indeed all the broadcasts in Pigin received good attention but CHRISTIANITY NO BE JUJU was a block buster! This is more interesting because when God gave me the message, I hesitated thinking about public reaction. Of course there was a mirage of negative reactions but I am thrilled that generally it was well received. As I prayed over the subject, I finally

concluded on preaching about it when I visited a church member and heard his neighbors quarrelling as it were. One said that his neighbor's wife will have miscarriage in Jesus name. The other one said that he sent holy ghost fire to destroy his neighbor's business. My inquiry revealed that these two were well know very serious church members in the neighborhood. I was told that their loud morning prayers were extension of their quarrels. I began to wonder what they thought Christianity was all about. These people simply carried over their pagan fetish beliefs and practices to church. They have not experienced salvation. Unfortunately, this is the case with many church folks in Nigeria today.

The erroneous thinking is that God exist for man. Truth however, is that man exist for God. This twisted theology makes man want to use God to achieve his purposes. God is sovereign, but today he is presented in the Nigerian church as subject to our whims and caprices. Scriptures are quoted out of context and interpreted to mean what was never intended by the author. God's word is brazenly used to manipulate fellow humans and in many cases used to take advantage of them. Compare and contrast the work of the native witch doctor and that of the pastor next

door and the results will be a wake-up call. Many who lead church congregations in this country have not met the Lord not to talk of knowing him. And the challenges of our under-developed economy and the system of primitive accumulation of wealth helped these men, whom the Apostle Paul tells us 'their god is their belly'. One of the ten commandments state "thou shall not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain", yet this is the daily practice. Jesus warned that blasphemy against the Holy Spirit will not be forgiven of men, yet the Holy Ghost is "invoked" as a matter of joke, anger, politics and or jealousy. The teaching of scripture is that 'the Lord prepares a table before me in the presence of our enemies', yet we command them to die. What are they waiting for? We query! Jesus told us to 'love our enemies and pray for those who treat us badly'. Or has the Bible been amended? Maybe I am the one reading a different bible.

I know that God is a consuming fire but where in the bible did he say that we should send him to consume people or things? In the gospels we find an interesting account, where some of the disciples wanted to call down fire to destroy a certain group of people because they did not receive the Lord Jesus in their Community. The sons of Zebedee James and John even referred to the Elijah event in the Old Testament and asked the Lord Jesus for permission to do the same. Jesus strongly and clearly rebuked them, forbidding them never to do so. I suggest you read the account yourself in Luke 9;51-56. Jesus said it again and again that he did not come to destroy men's lives. Why do we think we can force him to change his mind? The day in which he will judge the unrepentant wicked is coming ahead and no man has a hand in that matter.

Many times I have wondered if the early church had prayed such prayers for Saul of Tarsus and if God had answered, where we will be today? The truth is that Stephen at his death even prayed like our Lord did on the cross; "Father forgive them, for they know not what they do". And Saul became the mighty Apostle Paul.

But why do we pray these prayers in the Nigerian Church? (Take my word for it, I travel a little bit around the world, teaching and preaching the Bible on all Continents, I assure you that you will not hear such prayers anywhere else except in Nigeria and among Nigerians in the Diaspora). First reason is that our Christianity here is seriously mixed with our pagan beliefs. Many church folks here are not born again. They are mere church members. Indeed not to belong to a church in today's Nigeria makes one a social mis-fit. Another reason is the state of our economy and lawlessness. This has given rise to a situation, where just anybody can open a church and perform magic or deceive people just to make ends meet. Thus many church leaders in Nigeria today are themselves not Christians and have no theological training whatsoever. The pain is that those who should know are now joining the bandwagon in

order not to lose the crowd! Or to put it in biblical terms 'for filthy lucre's sake'.

Christianity is about personally knowing Jesus as Savior and Lord. It is about living like him and having heaven as your destination and focus. It is about loving people and taking as many as possible with you on this journey of faith. Christianity is about a changed life affecting other people. Christianity is love, forgiveness, good neighborliness, good citizenship, sacrifice and exemplary living. Christianity no be juju.

A WORD ABOUT CONVENTION 2013

I have been burdened in the recent years by the experience of seemingly born again children of God who suffer demonic oppression. I do not believe that a child of God can be possessed of the devil.
