CELEBRATING 30 YEARS OF GOD'S FAITHFULNESS IN MINISTRY

*"The Spirit bade me go, nothing doubting" Acts 11:12
"Whereupon I was not disobedient to the heavenly vision" Acts 26:19*

How time flies. It is thirty years already. I remember vividly Sunday morning 12th June 1982 at Ewvirhe Primary School Aladja where it all started. I had just finished my School Certificate Examinations (WASC) six days earlier. The call of God was so strong and clear. I abandoned all to serve him. At that time in the history of the church in Nigeria, it was a serious matter to respond positively to God's call. It was more or less a vow of poverty, complete separation from the world, and a life lived in view of the soon second coming of Christ. I lost all earthly ambitions and my one single purpose was to please God and to get as many people into heaven as possible. I never cared about what the world thought of me. My refrain was "1 Corinthians 9:16 For though I preach the gospel, I have nothing to boast of: for necessity is laid upon me; yea, woe is unto me, if I preach not the gospel!"

Have I changed? I leave that to those who know me to evaluate. But like the Apostle Paul, in Acts 24:16 'And in this do I exercise myself, to have

always a conscience void of offense toward God, and toward men'. And Philipians 3:13-14 "Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before, I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus". 1 Thessalonians 5:24 'Faithful is he that calls you, who also will do it'.
Of course I have matured over the years. Thirty years is no joke. I have seen a few things during these years. And I can not but thank the Lord for his faithfulness. Many who began at the same time are no more. Others have done better. But God has being good to me. There have been trials of diverse sorts and magnitudes. While not trying to measure with the Apostle Paul, permit me to again quote his experience in 2 Corinthians 11:23-29. "Are they ministers of Christ? (I speak as a fool) I am more; in labors more abundant, in stripes beyond measure, in prisons more frequent, in deaths often. Of the Jews five times received I forty stripes less one. Three times was I beaten with rods, once was I stoned, three times I suffered shipwreck, a night and a day I have been in the deep; In journeys often, in perils of waters, in perils of robbers, in perils by my own countrymen, in perils by the Gentiles, in perils in the city, in perils in the wilderness, in perils in the sea, in perils among false brethren; In weariness and painfulness, in watchings often, in hunger and thirst, in fastings often, in cold and nakedness.

REPORT ON CONVENTION 2012

Besides those things that are outside, that which comes upon me daily, the care of all the churches. Who is weak, and I am not weak? who is offended, and I burn not”?

And because I started pastoring in my late teens, I had no experience therefore suffering so much. Mentoring and fatherhood were not emphasized in those days. We all depended on the Holy Spirit as much as we could hear and understand him. And oh the mistakes and the heartaches! But God did not throw us away. Our hearts were right! Then there was the challenge of doctrinal imbalance and extreme teachings. Somehow today we maintain balance. As we see new methods of deception today we are amazed that satan has not changed. Who would have ever thought that men will use juju power to do church? The other day someone was discouraging another from worshipping with us and she told him that I was using “ordinary bible”. I wonder what else she expected me to use to do the work of the ministry.

One experience worth sharing is the need for tutelage before beginning an independent ministry even when God has called the individual to such a work. Today our church is fifteen years old while I am thirty in ministry. To be sure, I made the mistake also in the beginning. The years studying at Ekpoma and working at the Bank in Lagos helped come out of that. Having learnt, today our church enjoys the blessing of matured leadership backed-up with spiritual covering. And we have been spared the wahala of church politics and crisis. Of course we have had people leave us but by and large we have enjoyed stability. We have also been blessed to see the increase of God both as individual members and as a body. And this is what we celebrate. God has not only sustained us, he has increased us! When 'Chapel of the Anointing' (as it then was) started on 17th May 1997, some people never gave us a chance. But look at what God has done!

Many thousands have been saved, healed, delivered and blessed. Lives have been affected. We have minister to millions of souls through radio and television, we've provided relief and comfort to several thousands. We treated thousands who were sick with vital medicines at our clinic here in Warri and our outreaches in the islands of the delta. We provide free health, legal, educational and psycho-social care to hundreds of Orphans. Together, we changed lives. We delivered thousands of insecticide-treated mosquito nets to protect vulnerable mothers and children from malaria. We've made an immense difference to the people who needed it most. Our ministry has had a tangible, positive impact and our efforts to reach the lost with the saving gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ has been fruitful. Indeed God has been faithful. We have reasons to celebrate. You will notice that I have not mentioned the physical infrastructures that have been built or purchased during the years. Yes buildings have been built, vehicles purchased etc but ministry is about people. Someone told me years ago to consider my ministry a failure if souls are not been saved through our efforts. I can't forget that.

This has been an incredible journey and we accomplished quite a bit. I heard the Lord say to me the other night that the job is not ended yet. Much remains to be accomplished. I want to thank all our members and partners for all you've done during the years gone by. Without you we could not have made it. On behalf of our Elders, Ministers, Staff and the tens of

Rev Dr Slyvanus Kenerekedi in the evening session expounded on the healing of the Generest demoniac, contending that the man manifested as a son of God after his deliverance. He took time to draw parallels between the man's experience and ours today and emphasized the love and power of Jesus to heal us and make us manifest as his sons. He took time to pray for the congregation and raised offerings for the off-set of the cost of the Convention as well as a special seed for Rev Waive.

Sunday morning was the grand finale and it lived up to its billing. Rev Waive gave a powerful word from Daniel 3 about the son of God manifesting in the midst of the fiery furnace.
