GOD'S HELP IN THE STORMS OF LIFE

*"The Spirit bade me go, nothing doubting" Acts 11:12
"Whereupon I was not disobedient to the heavenly vision" Acts 26:19*


Storms ordinarily refer to very bad weather with a lot of wind, rain or snow. The difficult experiences that man goes through in the course of life on planet earth are the storms of life referred to in this subject title. It was Job who declared in Job 14:1 that 'Man that is born of a woman is of few days, and full of trouble'. It is important to note that God never promised a storm-free life even for the born again child of God. What he promised is his help in the storms of life which culminates in victory. So we find that life is full of storms and these storms have a way of rising suddenly. Even in nature, storms come without any warning. Be it in the health area or financial aspect of our lives, everyone experiences a storm at one time or the other. For some it is in relationships, on the job, in academics or in the family. It could be the loss of a loved one or business.

How we react when these things occur in our

lives is very crucial to our enjoying God's help in the storms of life. God's help is guaranteed for his children in the storms of life. Do not allow the storms of life to crush you, rather use the storms to soar to higher ground. Yes, storms crush some but elevate others. To benefit from the storm at the end of the day, we must always be ready for whatever may come and react knowing that the love and support of our God is certain.

Three different occasions of the rise of storms among many recorded in the scriptures come to my mind at the moment. The first is the famous story of Jonah. The storm he went through was caused by his own disobedience to God. How similar with our experiences today. If I were Jonah, I would have also dreaded going to Nineveh but I would have rather stayed at home than run from God. Where will I run to? Jonah's race from God ended him in a storm. He had to trace his step back and that at a great price. May we not get ourselves into a storm by our own disobedience. If you are already going through a storm by reason of your fault, I pray that the Lord show you mercy even as you repent at his feet.

The next storm that comes to mind is that which the Apostle Paul and his co-travellers experienced as recorded in Acts 27. The



MEN CONVENTION 2013 "GIVE ME MY INHERITANCE"

Harvesters Ministries Warri was the Keynote Speaker with our own Deacon Felix Ariole ministering on the first night. Brother Festus Omokaro, President of the Fellowship urged men in his welcome address to take full advantage of the program to better their lives.

In the first sermon, Dcn Ariole charged that inheritance had to be claimed even by force. He challenged Christians to live the life that God expected of them and be all that they can be. Rev Joseph Ikhine on the second night seemed to key into this when he emphasized that there is always opposition to claiming of inheritance. He challenged men present not to surrender to opposition but to be strong and claim what is rightfully theirs in Christ Jesus.

Just like he did on Saturday night, Rev Ikhine came with the Native Air Choir of Soul's Harvesters Ministries on Sunday morning. Joy his amiable wife was also with him. It was a great time indeed in the presence of the Lord as

Apostle had to go through this storm due to his interface with others. Left for him alone, he had heard from God and could not have been disobedient to the heavenly vision. But the others insisted on having their way. Everyone suffered, including the revered apostle. But God saved their lives for his sake. In the same way, we can go through a storm in our lives due to our interface with others. No man can be an inland to himself. Hence family and other relationships can result in stormy situations. I pray the Lord deliver you as he delivered Paul.

The third is the storm recorded in Mark's gospel chapter 4 ; 35 – 41, involving the disciples and our Lord Jesus. The trip was initiated by the Lord so man can be surprised at the occurrence of the storm. We find therefore that the storm is not an indication of the absence of the Lord or of his disapproval. Although this can be the case in certain cases, we should not distress ourselves believing that this is always the cause of the problems we go through in life. Rather let us learn from this story seeing how Jesus responded to this storm.

First we find that he intervened when the disciples called his attention. This should give us hope in prayers. Psalms 91:15 says 'He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honor him'. Many other scriptures encourage us to call upon the name of the Lord in the day of trouble. He promised to deliver us. This psalm tells us that he will not only deliver us but be with us in trouble. After delivering us, he promised to honor us. This is what the disciples experienced in Mark 4. I therefore encourage you to call upon the Lord in whatever storm you are going through in life. Do not faint and give up. Continue earnestly in prayers. There will be an answer.

Secondly, the Lord Jesus upon waking up did not spend time debating about the storm rather he spoke to it! I urge you to do the same. Speak to the storm in your life. We are assured in Mark 11:23 that "For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith". Let us stop all this complaining about that we do. Let us speak to the storm like our Lord Jesus did. Peace be still he said and there was a great calm!

Finally we see the disciples learning from the storm. They saw the Lord in a new dimension in which they had never known him previously. Mark 4:41 'And they feared exceedingly, and said one to another, What manner of man is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?' How I pray today that the present storm in your life will result in such a miracle that you will appreciate God better! That people around you will also see how God almighty has helped you in the storm of life and given you victory.
